- 2. Each submission must be made electronically in PDF format only.
- The submitting author must be the presenting author, although the presenting author does not have to be the first named author listed on the abstract.
- 4. Only one presenting author is permitted per paper.
- 5. All presentations must be in Power point format only.
- 6. Selected papers will be intimated via email.
- 7. All the participants are required to bring a hard copy of their paper along with them on the day of the event. In order to avoid any technical issues.
- 8. Violation of any rule can result in the rejection of paper.
- The front page of the paper should consist of participant names, college names.
- 10. Title must be on the top of the page

Date: 26th October 2024

Registration Fee: Rs 600 per team

Boundaries limiting play:

- Every player should be a physiotherapy student (BPT/INTERNEE/MPT) or teaching faculty.
- 2. Please wear T-shirts with uniform color code.
- 3. No player allowed to enter into the field without dress code
- Every team should get their own kit (balls & wickets will be arranged during the game).
- Umpire decision will be final. Appeal against umpire shall be considered as long as there is no indiscipline.
- Final 11 members name list is to be given to the referees before the toss.
- No refund of the Entry fee in any Circumstances.
- Any body found as an outsider, the game would be awarded to the opponents, Irrespective of the match result
- If the team is not arrived on time, match will be awarded to the opponents Match details:
- 1. Match innings: 10 over's (conditions apply)
- 2. Bowling limit: 3 Over's for one bowler
- 3. Power play: first 3 over's mandatory
- 4. By-runners: permitted by umpire's decisions
- 5. Change of Wicketkeeper: only once during the match
- 6. Wicketkeeper bowling: should field an over before bowling
- 7. LBW's & Leg byes are not taken into consideration
- 8. Byes, wides, no-balls, and over-throws: considered
- No balls: crease over stepping, bouncerNo-ball will lead to a free-hit
- 11. Tie match: Rowl-out

VOLLEY BALL -Men & Women

Date: 26th October 2024

Registration Fee: Rs 600 per team

- 1. A team of 10 Participants should be present (6 active, 4 substitute).
- Standard size ground (18m x 9m), centerline: 5m, serving arena: 3m and top of net height from ground: 2.43m.
- 3. Substitutions as per international rules.
- 4. All the matches will be 3-set match, with each set will be played for 15 points
- 5. Rally scoring to be used in all matches
- 6. The referee's decision shall be considered final.
- 7. A ball hitting a boundary line is IN
- A ball hitting the below is OUT Completely outside the court, The referee stand or pole.
- 9. It is illegal to catch, hold, or throw the ball
- 10. A player cannot block or attack a serve. (From on or inside the 10 foot line)
- 11. Touching the ball with head or foot is legal in the volley.
- 12. After the serve, front line players may switch positions at the net
- 13. All players should be dressed with a team Jersey
- 14. Serve ball is legal in spite touching net when it reaches the opponent court Volleyball Rules Violations
- The result of a violation is a point for the opponent.
- When serving, stepping on or across the service line as you make contact with the serve
- Failure to serve the ball over the net successfully
- Contacting the ball illegally (lifting, carrying, throwing, etc.)
- Touching the net with any part of the body while the ball is in play.
 When attacking a ball coming from the opponents court, contacting the ball when reaching over the net is a violation if the ball hasn't yet broken the vertical plane of the net.
- Crossing/Touching the court centreline with any part of your body is out
- Serving out of order. (Rotation of serve is mandatory)

CARROMS (DOUBLES) Men & Women

Date: 26th October 2024

Registration Fee: Rs 300 per team

RULES OF CAROMS

- For each strike, the player must position the striker within the baseline or on one of the two circles at either end of the baseline.
- 5 points for the queen and 1 point each for black & white carom men
- . Foul (if valid) will be given only If the opponent claims it.
- Striker may not "cut the moon" be placed partially within the baseline and partially within the circle.
- A striker within the baseline must touch both the front line and the rear line.
- The player must flick the striker with one finger so that it crosses the front baseline it is not permitted to flick backwards or horizontally. Back shots (thumbing) not allowed.
- A piece that is on or behind the front baseline must not be struck by the striker until the striker has crossed the front baseline
- In striking, the player's hand or arm must not cross the diagonal foul lines at either end of the baseline.
- · Match referee decision is final.

Other Rules:

- Pieces returned to the centre can be placed on top of other pieces within the main circle.
- If pieces come to rest standing on their edge or overlapping another piece, they are left as they are until moved again in the normal course of play.
- If the striker comes to rest under another piece, the striker should be removed with as little disturbance to the covering piece as possible.

SHUTTLE BADMINTON (DOUBLES) Men & Women Date: 26th October 2024 | Registration Fee: Rs 300 per team Rules and Regulations:

- · All the rounds shall be 3 game rounds
- · Last Date for Registration: 15th October 2024.
- For each game, the first player to reach 15 points (11 points for Women) wins that game
- If a score of 14-14 reached in any game, 'set' the game to 17 (13) points.
- The side winning a game serves first in the next game. Only the serving side can add a point to its score.
- You shall serve from, and receive in, the right service court when you or your opponent has scored an even number of points in that game.
- · You shall serve from, and receive in, the left service court when you or
- You and your opponent will hit the shuttle alternately until a 'fault is made or the shuttle ceases to be in play.
- When your opponent's partner touched or hit the shuttle, it shall be a 'fault' and your side scores a point.
- Serve continuing is not allowed. (for doubles)
- · Only one team is allowed from each college
- No shouting when the bird is on the other side of the court.

Rules:

- 1. If you arrive the court late by 30mintues (without prior notice), you will be forfeited automatically.
- 2. Behaving badly inappropriately is not acceptable
- Umpire's decision is final. If the umpire cannot take the decision, match referee will take the decision.
- If you have any questions, please clarify before the match, not during the match.

- 4. Understand the "touch-move" rule.
- Understand 50 moves draw rule i.e. the game can be claimed drawn after 50 moves if there are no pawn moves or no captures.
- Understand 3 fold repetition rule. The game can be claimed drawn if the exact same position is repeated thrice.
- 7. No outside assistance during games is allowed.

Winning: According to the powers on the board after 15 mins

Stalemate: If a player's King is not in Check, but any possible move places him in Check, it's a Stalemate


